FAREWELL TO A WARRIOR PRINCE

HRH Prince Philip, the Duke of Edinburgh, was one of those rare men who knew what needed to be done, how to give advice, leadership and support and at the same time remain a humble man.

His experience in the Navy taught him the benefits of discipline and knowledge, whilst the travel involved introduced him to people in many parts of the world. Australia was not an unknown country to him - he made 21 visits to our cities and towns and made many friends in the different States. But his biggest role was his support for Queen Elizabeth in their 73 years of marriage and becoming the longest serving Royal Consort. He was her confidant, stepping back as she took the limelight but always by her side when advice was needed, or to ease an awkward situation. Sometimes he spoke out of turn when in public but seemed to enjoy the moment,

especially with a family which would have given any father a headache.

The Duke hated fuss and arranged his own funeral, every element chosen to reflect his many interests and a
