METRO MOVES

The demolition of 175 Castlereagh St is expected to be completed down to ground level by Friday 24 November.

Scaffolding has been erected on the old Windsor Hotel building and the adjoining buildings are expected to be demolished by Christmas time. We should then receive a few years of relief as Sydney Metro builds the underground station and foundations for the building above ground level. This is expected to be approximately 47 storeys.

The Directors are currently seeking meetings with the State Government and City of Sydney Council regarding the proposed height of the new building's podium level and the setback from our building.
